



Project Ploughshares Planned Giving: Bequests

You can make a lasting contribution to the peacemaking and peacebuilding work of Project Ploughshares by directing some of your accumulated resources to the Project through a bequest in your will. These assets might be cash, securities, life insurance, or retirement fund assets (RRSPs and RRIFs). As well, by designating your RRSPs and RRIFs directly to Project Ploughshares you can significantly offset tax liability at death.

There are many options to review in the disposition of your estate. Depending on the method you choose, there may even be an immediate tax benefit for you. In order to choose the option best for you, discuss your plans with your family and consult your lawyer or financial advisor.
